ABOUT ARC

The Association for the Recovery of Children is a 501(c)(3) (est. 1993) made up of former intelligence (CIA), military special operators, and law-enforcement personnel who rescue missing, exploited, abducted, or trafficked American children held in the U.S. or overseas. Their all-encompassing

recovery program comes at no cost to custodial parents.

ARC's President, **Bazzel Baz**, personally leads every rescue mission with a Strike Force Recovery Team (SFRT). Their training draws directly on the tradecraft those operators use in the field.

WHAT THE 6 DAYS COVER

DAY 1 **The criminal enterprise**

Terms and law, the business model of trafficking, familial and gang trafficking, traffickers' tools and tactics.

DAY 2 **The fight against it**

Coordinated strategy, tactical methods, OSINT, secure communications, law enforcement and prosecution.

DAY 3 **Demand & victimology**

The buyers, how victims become vulnerable, recruitment and bondage, identifying a possible victim — with guest presenters.

DAY 4 **Intervention**

Where to find victims, how to interact, medical considerations, trauma-informed assistance and building trust.

DAY 5 **Operations & surveillance**

Starting an NGO, covert pickup, surveillance and counter-surveillance, and conducting a safe rescue and transport.

DAY 6 **Operations order & exercise**

A 5-paragraph operations order, a group practical exercise and presentations, then certification.

HOST A COURSE IN YOUR AREA

ARC's training staff will guide any group interested in hosting the 6-day course. The host books the venue (ARC is typically booked 6–12 months out), registers a minimum of 30 participants at least a month ahead, and provides A/V, plus travel and lodging for the training staff. Reach out through ARC to start.
